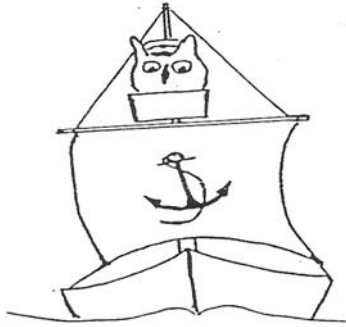




Boatwise Note Card Contest

Contest Rules

1. The entry must be in colour on poster card; size 10 cm x 13 cm.
2. Note cards will be judged for idea more than artistic ability.
3. Original art only; computer generated art, photos, professional illustrations, copyright material may not be used.
4. The contest entry form must be completed and pasted on the back of the note card. Only one entry drawn by one person please.
5. Do not fold art work.
6. Judging will be at the Squadron level first, then at District. Six entries per District will be judged at the National Conference, three for each category.
7. All District entries should be given to the Youth Education Committee by the first day of the conference.

ADDENDUM "A"

Authorization to Use an Artistic Work

- 1) The contestant represents and warrants that the artistic work is original and that he or she is its sole creator;
 - 2) The contestant forever allows the Corporation to use the artistic work, in part or in whole, alone or in conjunction with other works, in any and all documents it currently edits or publishes or may eventually edit or publish, in whatever format, including but not restricted to its squadron, district or national educational or promotional materials, publications, magazines, periodicals, reviews, or web-pages or sites, provided that :
 - a) the Corporation does not sell, assign, or otherwise transfer the artistic work to a third party in consideration of a commercial gain or return or in furtherance of a commercial venture;
 - b) the Corporation uses the artistic work only in furtherance of its educational or promotional activities;
 - 3) The contestant relinquishes and waives any right he or she may have to a financial consideration or compensation for the use of his or her artistic work;
 - 4) It is expressly understood that this authorization does not constitute an assignment or transfer of copyrights, intellectual rights or moral rights the contestant has or may have over the artistic work, and that any right the contestant has or may have in respect to the artistic work is hereby waived in favour of the Corporation only to the extent stipulated herein.

ADDENDUM "B"

Parental consent

- 1) During the period of the contestant's minority, he or she shall perform and abide by the provisions of the foregoing agreement on his or her part to be observed and/or performed thereunder;
- 2) Parents relinquish any right which they may have for themselves or on behalf of their child over the artistic work;
- 3) Parents will jointly and severally indemnify and hold the Corporation harmless from any and all claims, losses, damages and costs, including actual legal fees, which the Corporation may incur:
 - a) by reason of a breach or purported breach of the provisions of this Consent;
 - b) by reason of the contestant's breach or purported breach of any representation or warranty or other agreement set forth in the above Authorization to Use an Artistic Work;
 - c) by reason of the contestant's revocation or renunciation of, or other action in respect to, the foregoing Authorization upon reaching the age of majority
